### Buttons on your radio: Handheld

top left: push to talk bottom left: monitor (not used)

A: Scan B: TalkAround C: Lamp or Dual Watch

### Buttons on your radio: Mobile

A: Scan SCN: Scan A/D: add/delete from scan Mon: Page

to check pager tone: press mon, use up down until on "mtvernon" press mon

\*\*\*to page... hold down transmit button on mic, press "mon" button

(HANDHELDS) Radio should be left on 'FIREPAGE' unless scanning. To reset the radio after a page, turn the radio off and then back on.

How to respond to a fire page: turn radio to 'FIREFITR' channel.

Mt Vernon (#) to Central will be responding to the station

e.g. Mt Vernon 5 to Central --- will be responding to the station.

Give it all in once sentence, don't wait for central to call back and then give your traffic.

e.g. MV14 to Central, responding to station. **Central: copy 14.**

**Alternate response: MV14 to Central, copy house fire 101 columbia 55, responding to station** [this way if you got the address wrong, they will tell you (or should)]

After you hear one firefighter respond, you tell the firefighter that has responded that you are responding. Only

**\*ONE\*** person is to tell central they are responding. Say 14 6 and 9 are responding.

1 MV6 to MV14, I'm responding to the station.

2 **MV14: 10-4 MV6 copy responding to station (so now MV6 is the top responder)**

3 MV9 to MV6, I'm responding directly to the fire (or station whatever, just let them know)

4 **MV6: 10-4 MV9, copy responding directly to the fire (or...) MV6: negative MV9, respond to station & get a truck**

5 MV9: copy going to get a truck

Always repeat your traffic back so there is no misunderstanding on what you are doing.
